# aged over 16 and under the age of 19 on 1st September 2019?

Take your original birth certificate, driving licence, passport or expired POP Card to any Travelcentre, together with a current passport style photograph. You will be given a Network One Photocard and a Network One Young Person's ID Card, which will have the six-digit number from your Network One Photocard written on it and the date of your 19th birthday. You can use this ID Card to buy Network One Tickets for Students and Young People.

If you lose your Network One Young Person's ID Card, you can get a replacement by taking your original birth certificate, driving licence, passport or expired POP Card to any Travelcentre, together with a current passport style photograph.

### Young Person's ID Card - This bit is important!

- The Young Person's ID Card will be valid until the applicant's 19th birthday.
- ID Cards will be available in person only from Network One Agencies.
- Applicants must be over the age of 16 and under the age of 19 on 1st September 2019.
- Applicants must bring original birth certificate, driving licence, passport or expired POP Card to obtain their ID Card.
- Applicants must be in possession of a Network One Photocard, or be issued with one before the ID Card can be issued.
- Lost ID Cards can only be replaced upon production of original birth certificate, driving licence, passport or expired POP Card.
- A current Student or Young Person's ID Card should be produced to the drivers/inspectors or other revenue protection staff when requested.

Failure to present a valid ticket may result in a penalty fare or possible prosecution.

If your Student ID Card shows all of the following information you can use this ID Card to buy Network One Tickets for Students and Young People:

- Name of educational establishment.
- Student's name.
- Student's current passport style photograph.
- That the student is a full time student.
- An expiry date.

If your Student ID Card does not show all of this information you cannot use the ID Card to buy Network One Tickets for Students and Young People, and you should apply for a Network One ID Card using the form overleaf.

A current passport style photograph and certification of your eligibility will be required for your first ticket.

Network One Tickets for Students and Young People cannot be issued if the appropriate ID Card is not produced at time of purchase.
